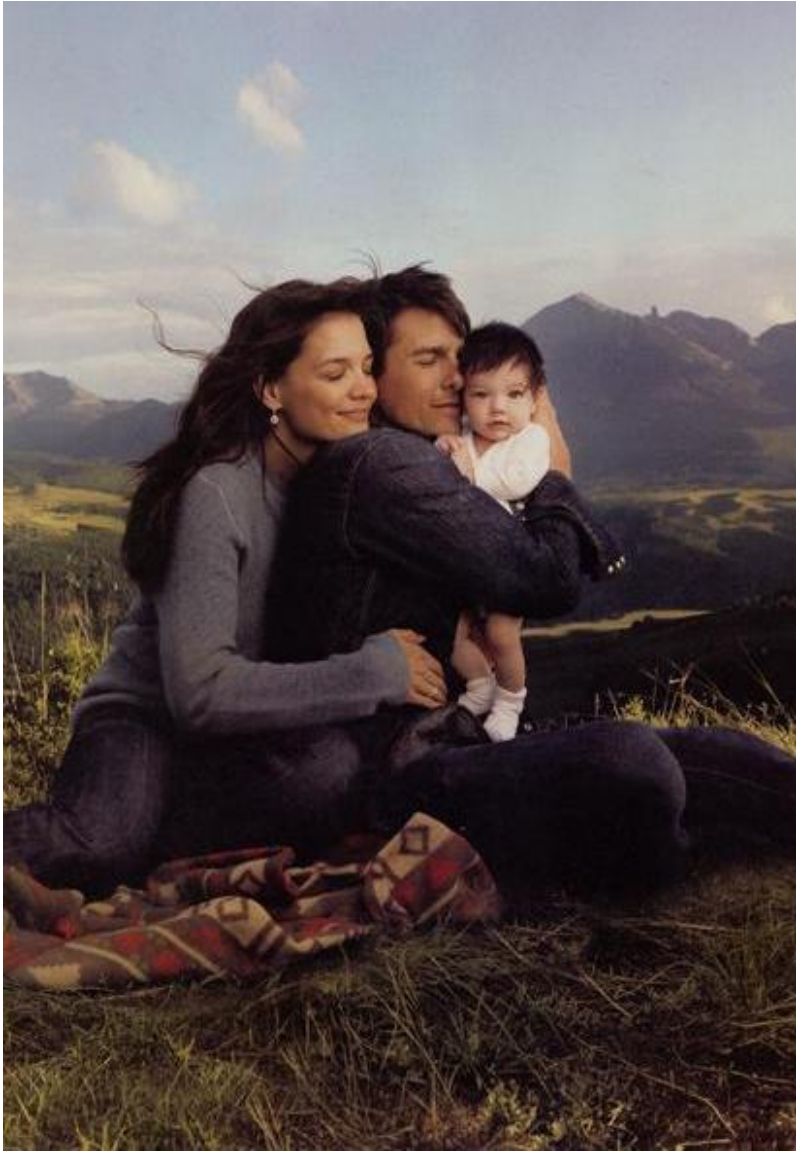

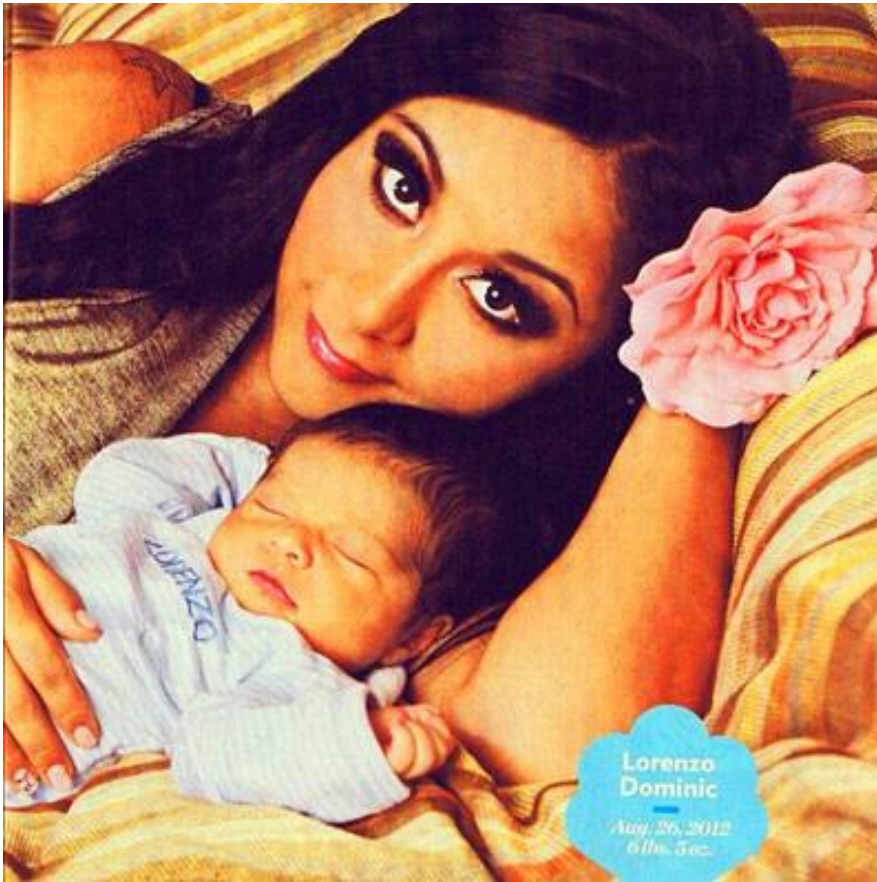
Mariah happily breastfed her twins Monroe and Moroccan in tandem, with one baby on each arm.
